needs help finding fresh grass and water so he can be healthy and safe




keeps his sheep in safe green pastures and brings them to fresh drinking spots

Jesus said, "If a man has 100 sheep, but I of them gets lost, he will leave the other 99 sheep on the hill. He will go to look for the lost sheep. And if he finds it, he is happier about that I sheep than about the 99 that were never lost." Matt. 18:12–13 ICB.
